STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-eight of chapter eleven of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section twenty-eight of chapter eleven

- 2 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, by insert-
- 3 ing after the word "officers" in the fifth line thereof,
- 4 the words, "or resides without the limits of this state,
- 5 and has no agent or attorney within the same;" and
- 6 by inserting after the word "damages" in the eighth
- 7 line thereof, the words, "or if such owner shall not
- 8 reside within this state, upon depositing such damages
- 9 in the treasury of such town or district for his use,"
- 10 so that said section as amended by chapter one hun-

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- 11 dred and three of the laws of eighteen hundred sixty-
- 12 two, and by this act, shall read as follows:
- 13 "Sect. 28. When a location for the erection or
- 14 removal of a school house and necessary buildings has
- 15 been legally designated, and the owner thereof refuses
- 16 to sell or asks an unreasonable price for it, in the opin-
- 17 ion of the municipal officers, or resides without the
- 18 limits of this state, and has no authorized agent or
- 19 attorney within the same, they may lay out a school
- 20 house lot not exceeding forty square rods, and appraise
- 21 the damages, as is provided for laying out town ways
- 22 and appraising damages therefor; and on payment or
- 23 tender of such damages, or if such owner shall not
- 24 reside within this state, upon depositing such damages
- 25 in the treasury of such town or district for his use, the
- 26 town or district designating it may take such lot to be
- 27 held and used for the purposes aforesaid; and when
- 28 such school house as is required of the town or district
- 29 has ceased to be thereon for two years, it shall revert
- 30 to the owner, his heirs or assigns."
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved 2 by the governor.
