STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to authorize certain town officers to remove fences to prevent snow-drifts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The selectmen of towns, or highway
- 2 surveyors under the direction of selectmen, may take
- 3 down fences upon the line of public highways in this
- 4 state when in their judgment the same is necessary to
- 5 prevent the drifting of snow in such highways; but in
- 6 all such cases fences so taken down shall in due season
- 7 be replaced in as good condition as when taken down,
- 8 without expense to the owner.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
