## STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to prevent obstructions to travel.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby forbidden to 2 place rocks, stones, or any obstructions, in the traveled 3 roads in this state, and leave them there, under pen-4 alty of a fine of one dollar for each and every offence, 5 to be recovered to the use of the town where the 6 offence is committed, on complaint before any compe-7 tent tribunal.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
