IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT for the further protection of persons who have policies in marine insurance companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. In all cases where a policy of insurance
- 2 has been issued by any insurance company, and a note
- 3 given for the premium that may be due on said policy,
- 4 the policy and note shall be treated as parts of the
- 5 same contract; and any loss occurring under the policy
- 6 for which the company issuing the policy may be lia-
- 7 ble, shall or may be applied to the said note, whether
- 8 such note is in the hands of the company or their
- 9 assignee or assignees.
 - SECT. 2. Where the insurance company is a foreign

- 2 corporation, and has issued a policy to an inhabitant
- 3 of this state, and loss accrues, such foreign corporation
- 4 may be sued and jurisdiction sustained if service be
- 5 made by a copy of writ and declaration upon any mem-
- 6 ber of such corporation, who may be an inhabitant of
- 7 this state, and resides in the county where such action
- 8 is brought.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
