STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT in relation to the competency of witnesses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. In the trial of all civil and criminal ac-
- 2 tions, the husband and wife of either party shall be
- 3 deemed competent witnesses.
 - SECT. 2. An act entitled "an act in relation to the
- 2 competency of witnesses," approved April second,
- 3 eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, and an act entitled
- 4 "an act to amend chapter one hundred and two of the
- 5 public laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-nine relative
- 6 to the competency of witnesses," approved February
- 7 twenty-third, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, are
- 8 hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved 2 by the governor.
