IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT additional to chapter ninety-one of the revised statutes in relation to liens on goods in possession.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Any innholder or keeper of a boarding-2 house in this state shall have a lien upon the goods 3 and personal baggage of his guests or boarders to se-4 cure the payment of any money due from such guests 5 or boarders for board and lodging, and may enforce 6 such lien by a sale of such goods and personal baggage 7 in the manner provided in sections twenty-four, twen-8 ty-five, twenty-six, twenty-seven, twenty-eight, twen-9 ty-nine, thirty and thirty-one of chapter ninety-one of

10 the revised statutes relative to liens on goods in pos-11 session.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
