
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT in addition to chapter ninety-two of the revised statutes, relating to flowing lands and diverting water for purposes of mills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. In addition to the mode of service

- 3 inserted in a writ of attachment and served as other
- 4 writs by attachment, summons and copy.
