## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend chapter fifteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred fifty-eight in relation to liens upon vessels.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section twenty-four of chapter fifteen

- 2 of the public laws of eighteen hundred fifty-eight is
- 3 hereby amended by striking out the words "the
- 4 court," in the first line, and inserting instead thereof,
- 5 the words "any justice of said court, in vacation,"
- 6 and also, by adding after the word "meaning," in the
- 7 last line, the following, "and when it shall appear to
- 8 such judge, upon a hearing, after a reasonable notice
- 9 to the parties in interest, that the vessel, so attached,

- 10 is kept at great expense and loss to the owners or lien
- 11 claimants, he may order such vessel to be sold by the
- 12 attaching officer, and the proceeds paid into the court,
- 13 where the first writ of attachment is returnable, sub-
- 14 ject to the provisions in sections eighteen and nineteen
- 15 of said chapter," so that the section as amended shall
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 "Sect. 24. Any justice of said court in vacation in
- 18 the manner of a court sitting in admiralty, may make
- 19 such orders and decrees as may be necessary for carry-
- 20 ing out the provisions of this act according to their
- 21 true intent and meaning; and when it shall appear to
- 22 such judge upon a hearing, after a reasonable notice
- 23 to the parties in interest, that the ship or vessel, so
- 24 attached, is kept at great expense and loss to the
- 25 owners or lien claimants, he may order such ship or
- 26 vessel to be sold by the attaching officer, and the pro-
- 27 ceeds paid into the court where the first writ of attach-
- 28 ment is returnable, subject to the provisions in sections
- 29 eighteen and nineteen in said chapter."
  - Sect. 2. Any person described in section one of
  - 2 said chapter fifteen, and having a lien for labor or
  - 3 materials furnished for building a ship or vessel, may,
  - 4 if he does not see fit to enforce such lien by attach-
- 5 ment within the time mentioned in said section, pre-

6 serve such lien by filing within four days from the 7 time such ship or vessel departs from the port at which 8 she was when the debt was contracted, in the office of 9 the clerk of the city or town within which the ship or 10 vessel was at the time the debt was contracted, a 11 statement, subscribed and sworn to by himself or some 12 person in his behalf, giving a just and true account of 13 the demand claimed to be due to him, with all just 14 credits, and also the name of the person with whom 15 the contract was made, the name of the owner of the 16 ship or vessel, if known, and the name of the ship or 17 vessel; which statement shall be recorded by the clerk 18 of such city or town in a book kept by him for that 19 purpose, and such lien may afterwards be enforced by 20 attachment in the manner provided by said chapter 21 fifteen.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved 2 by the governor.
