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## AMENDMENTS ADOPTED BY THE SENATE TO SENATE DOCUMENT NO. 11, BEING AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE EQUALIZATION OF MUNICIPAL WAR DEBTS.

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### A.

Sect. 3—Add after the word “plantation,” in the  
2 fifth line, “and a duplicate of the same to the state  
3 treasurer.”

### B.

Sect. 3—Add after the word “by,” in the sixth line,  
2 “the treasurer of said municipality or”.

### C.

Sect. 4—Add after the word “state,” in the third line,  
2 “by issuing the bonds thereof”.

### D.

Sect 4—Add after the word “Boston,” in the elev-  
2 enth line, “or at the treasury of Maine, at the option  
3 of the holder”.

## E.

Sect. 5—Strike out after the word “nine,” in the  
2 third line, the following, “a sum equal to two mills  
3 on every dollar of the present state valuation,” and  
4 substitute therefor the following, “the interest on such  
5 sums as said commission may find due under the pro-  
6 visions of this act, together with such a sum for a  
7 sinking fund as invested year by year will meet the  
8 payment of said bonds at their maturity”.

## F.

Add to the bill the following section :

SECT. 14. No payment shall be made to any city,  
2 town or plantation under the provisions of this act,  
3 until all sums due to the state from said city, town or  
4 plantation shall be fully liquidated”.

## G.

Sect. 1—Strike out all after the word “period,” in  
2 the eighth line, to the word “war,” in the twelfth  
3 line.”

## H.

Sect. 6—After the word “representatives,” eleventh  
2 line, add, “no money or bonds shall be paid to any  
3 city, town or plantation for men when it is in evidence  
4 that said credit was granted by the state as a gratuity  
5 for which they have paid no consideration.”

## I.

Sect. 6—Add to the eleventh line after the word  
2 “or,” “if deceased, to”.

## K.

Amend section six, line eleventh, by inserting after  
2 the word “enlisted,” the words, “or were drafted and  
3 went”.

## L.

Amend by striking out all of section one, after the  
2 words “Section 1,” and inserting the following words:  
3 “Each city, town and plantation shall receive and be  
4 reimbursed from the state two hundred dollars for  
5 every man furnished for the military service of the  
6 United States towards its quota for the term of three  
7 years under the call of the president of July second,  
8 eighteen hundred and sixty-two, and all subsequent  
9 calls, and in the same proportion for every man so  
10 furnished and accepted for any shorter period, in man-  
11 ner as hereinafter provided.”

## M.

Amend section four, in lines three and four, by strik-  
2 ing out the words “three million five hundred thou-  
3 sand” and inserting in lieu thereof the words “seven  
4 millions”.

## N.

Amend section seven by adding at its close the following words: “for its corporate purposes; but in no case shall the same be divided per capita, or distributed in any manner among the inhabitants thereof.”

## O.

Amend section sixth, in the tenth and eleventh lines, by striking out the words “to fill such quotas,” and insert instead the following: “at any time during the war.”

## P.

Amend section seven, in seventh line, by inserting after the word “act” the following: “and as provided for in section sixth.”
