AMENDMENTS ADOPTED BY THE SENATE TO RESOLVES PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT OF THE CONSTITUTION.

A.

Amend first resolve in line six by striking out XI
2 and inserting XIII.

B.

Amend first resolve in line fifteen by striking out the
2 word "one" and inserting the word "two" in lieu
3 thereof.

C.

Amend first resolve by striking out all after the word
2 "period" in twenty-first line down to and inclusive
3 of the word "it" in line twenty-six of same resolve.

D.

Amend first resolve in lines thirty-two and thirty-
2 three by striking out the words "three million five

3 hundred thousand” and inserting in lieu thereof the
4 words “seven millions.”

E.

Amend second resolve in lines eleven and twelve by
2 striking out the words “three million five hundred
3 thousand” and inserting in lieu thereof the words
4 “seven millions.”

F.

Add after the word “period” in the twenty-first line
2 of the first resolve—“and the same shall be in full
3 payment for any claim upon the state on account of
4 its ‘war debts’ by any such municipality.”

G.

Amend first resolve in lines twenty-seven and
2 twenty-eight by striking out the following words,
3 “exclusively towards the payment of its corporate
4 debt, if such debt exists,” and inserting instead there-
5 of the following words, “to such reimbursement, the
6 surplus, if any, to be appropriated to the soldiers who
7 enlisted or were drafted and went at any time during
8 the war, or if deceased, to their legal representa-
9 tives.”
