IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT relating to reviews in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. A review may be granted in any case 2 wherein judgment has been or hereafter shall be ren-3 dered when it appears that justice has not been done 4 through fraud, accident, mistake or misfortune, and 5 that a further hearing would be just and equitable; 6 *provided* a petition therefor is presented to the court 7 within six years after the rendition of judgment.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
