## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to continue in force and amendatory of chapter seventy-eight of the resolves of eighteen hundred sixty-seven, in relation to the restoration of sea fish to the rivers and inland waters of Maine.

Resolved, That chapter seventy-eight, a resolve ap-

- 2 proved January twenty-eight, eighteen hundred and
- 3 sixty-seven, relative to the restoration of sea fish to
- 4 the rivers and inland waters of Maine, be and hereby
- 5 is continued in force for the term of two years, subject
- 6 to the amendment hereafter provided.

Resolved, That chapter seventy-eight of the resolve

- 2 approved January twenty-eight, eighteen hundred and
- 3 sixty-seven, be amended, by striking out in the sec-
- 4 ond resolve, after the words "the sum of," the words
- 5 one thousand dollars, and insert the words fifteen hun-

- 6 dred dollars annually, so that the sentence shall read,
- 7 provided the expense does not exceed the sum of fif-
- 8 teen hundred dollars annually.

Resolved, That the commissioners appointed under

- 2 this resolve make an annual report to the governor and
- 3 council, who shall cause five hundred copies of the
- 4 same to be printed for distribution.
