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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE to continue in force and amendatory of chapter seventy-eight of the resolves of eighteen hundred sixty-seven, in relation to the restoration of sea fish to the rivers and inland waters of Maine.

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*Resolved,* That chapter seventy-eight, a resolve approved January twenty-eight, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, relative to the restoration of sea fish to the rivers and inland waters of Maine, be and hereby is continued in force for the term of two years, subject to the amendment hereafter provided.

*Resolved,* That chapter seventy-eight of the resolve approved January twenty-eight, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, be amended, by striking out in the second resolve, after the words "the sum of," the words one thousand dollars, and insert the words fifteen hun-

6 dred dollars annually, so that the sentence shall read,  
7 provided the expense does not exceed the sum of fif-  
8 teen hundred dollars annually.

*Resolved,* That the commissioners appointed under  
2 this resolve make an annual report to the governor and  
3 council, who shall cause five hundred copies of the  
4 same to be printed for distribution.
