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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

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AN ACT giving certain powers to the commissioners of fisheries.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. During the continuance in force of chapter seventy-eight of the resolves of eighteen hundred sixty-seven, entitled " resolve relative to the restoration of sea fish to the rivers and inland waters of Maine," the commissioners appointed under said resolve may, at their discretion, on petition of three or more responsible persons, exercise the powers granted to county commissioners in sections twenty-two, twenty-three and twenty-four of chapter forty of the revised statutes ; and the proceedings shall be as pro-

11 vided in said sections, but this act shall not be so  
12 construed as to give the commissioners any other pay  
13 than that derived from the resolve continuing in force  
14 chapter seventy-eight of the resolves of eighteen hun-  
15 dred sixty-seven.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
