STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT additional to and amendatory of an act establishing the times of holding the several terms of the supreme judicial court, approved February twenty-eighth, eighteen hundred sixty-seven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. In addition to the terms now provided
2 by law, the supreme judicial court shall be held, annu-
3 ally, by one of the justices thereof, at the times and
4 places following :

5 In the county of Somerset, at Norridgewock, on the
6 third Tuesday of December.

7 In the county of Waldo, at Belfast, on the first Tues-
8 day of January.

SECT. 2. The supreme judicial court shall be held
2 on the first Tuesday of October, annually, at Bangor,
3 within and for the county of Penobscot, instead of the
4 third Tuesday of October, as is now provided by law.
5 And shall be held on the third Tuesday of May, annu-
6 ally, at Alfred, within and for the county of York,
7 instead of the fourth Tuesday of April, as is now pro-
8 vided by law.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
