## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT increasing the amount of money which towns shall raise for the support of schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Every city, town and plantation, shall

- 2 raise and expend annually, for the support of schools
- 3 therein, a sum of money, exclusive of the income of
- 4 any corporate school fund, or of any grant from the
- 5 revenue or funds from the state, or of any voluntary
- 6 donation, devise or bequest, or of any forfeiture accru-
- 7 ing to the use of schools, not less than one dollar for
- 8 each inhabitant, according to the census of the state
- 9 by which representatives to the legislature were last
- 10 apportioned.

- SECT. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with 2 the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
  - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
