IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to enable parties to written contracts to fix the rate of interest on the same.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Interest shall remain at six per centum, as now 2 established by law; *provided however*, that parties to 3 written contracts are hereby authorized to fix and 4 determine the rate of interest on the same.
