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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE relating to Antietam National Cemetery.

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WHEREAS, that by an act entitled “an act to establish and to protect national cemeteries,” approved 2 February twenty-second, eighteen hundred and sixty- 3 seven, congress has adopted a uniform system for the 4 management and care of all the soldiers’ national 5 cemeteries throughout the United States and made pro- 6 visions for their maintenance, therefore be it

*Resolved, by the Senate and House of Representatives* 2 *of the State of Maine in Legislature assembled, That* 3 we respectfully request of and recommend to the legis- 4 lature of the State of Maryland, the passage of an act 5 empowering the board of trustees having charge of the 6 Antietam National Cemetery at Sharpsburg, Md., to 7 transfer all the right, title, interest and care of said

8 Antietam National Cemetery to the general govern-  
9 ment upon the completion of the same.

*Resolved,* That the governor be requested to cause a  
2 copy of these resolutions to be forwarded to the gov-  
3 ernor of Maryland and to the board of trustees having  
4 charge of the Antietam National Cemetery.
