STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to Soldiers' National Cemetery.

WHEREAS, that by an act entitled "an act to estab-

- 2 lish and to protect national cemeteries," approved
- 3 February twenty-second, eighteen hundred and sixty-
- 4 seven, congress has adopted a uniform system fer tho
- 5 management and care of all the soldiers' national
- 6 cemeteries throughout the United States and made
- 7 provisions for their maintenance; therefore be it

Resolved, by the Senate and House of Representatives

- 2 of the State of Maine in Legislature assembled, That
- 3 we respectfully request of and recommend to the legis-
- 4 lature of the State of Pennsylvania the passage of an
- 5 act empowering the board of commissioners having
- 6 charge of the Soldiers' National Cemetery at Gettys-
- 7 burg, Pa., to transfer all the right, title, interest and

- 8 care of said Soldiers' National Cometery to the general
- 9 government upon the completion of the same.

Resolved, That the governor be requested to cause a

- 2 copy of these resolutions to be forwarded to the gov-
- 3 ernor of Pennsylvania and to the board of commis-
- 4 sioners having charge of the Soldiers' National Ceme-
- 5 tery at Gettysburg, in said state.
