STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to acts establishing and regulating
the Penobscot Boom Corporation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The tenth section of the act additional
2 to acts establishing and regulating the Penobscot
3 Boom Corporation, approved April fifth, eighteen hun-
4 dred and fifty-four, giving authority to the said boom
5 corporation to lease its boom to the Penobscot Lum-
6 bering Association, is hereby renewed and extended
7 for the term of fifteen years, except that the charter
8 of said corporation is hereby extended fifteen years
9 instead of twenty years as before.

SECT. 2. If said association should neglect to take
2 the lease or should abandon the duties imposed, and

3 the boom should come back into the management of
4 the corporation, the toll fixed at fifty-three cents in
5 the first section of said act is hereby raised to sixty-
6 five cents and to continue for one year only after the
7 boom so comes back.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when signed by
2 the governor.
