STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional relating to the proof and effect of wills executed in another state or country.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The several statutes relating to the proof and effect
2 of wills executed in any other state or country, are
3 amended so that any will made and executed in any
4 foreign country or in any other of the United States,
5 according to the laws thereof, shall be valid and have
6 the same force and effect in this state, as if made and
7 executed in the manner prescribed by the laws thereof,
8 if at the time of his death the testator was a resident
9 of this state, whether said will is originally proved and
10 allowed in this state, or is allowed and recorded in
11 any probate court in this state upon the production of

12 a certified copy thereof and proof that it has been
13 proved and allowed in any other state or country.
