STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT concerning the rate of interest.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. When there is no agreement for a dif-2 ferent rate of interest of money, the same shall con-3 tinue to be at the rate of six dollars upon one hundred 4 dollars for a year, and at the same rate for a greater 5 or less sum and for a longer or shorter time.

SECT. 2. It shall be lawful to contract to pay or 2 reserve discount at any rate, and to contract for pay-3 ment and receipt of any rate of interest; *provided* 4 *however*, that no greater rate of interest than six per 5 centum per annum shall be recovered in any action, 6 except when the agreement to pay such greater rate 7 of interest is in writing.

SECT. 3. Sections two and three of chapter forty-2 five of the revised statutes, and all acts and parts of 3 acts inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECT. 4. This act shall not affect any existing con-2 tract, or action pending, or existing right of action, 3 and shall take effect on the first day of April next.
