STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT in addition to the several acts relating to mortgages of personal property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. If the mortgagor of personal property, 2 retaining possession of the same with the consent of 3 the mortgagee, shall sell the said property, or any 4 part thereof, or in any way part with or dispose of 5 the same, without the written consent of the mortgagee, so that the mortgagee cannot obtain possession 6 upon demand thereof of the mortgagor, he shall be 7 held to be guilty of a misdemeanor, and punished by 8 a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding one year.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved 2 by the governor.
