## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to repeal an act additional to chapter sixty of the revised statutes relating to divorce, approved March twenty-seventh, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, and additional to chapter of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter forty-five of the public acts of
- 2 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
- 3 fifty-eight, entitled an act additional to chapter sixty
- 4 of the revised statutes relating to divorce, is hereby
- 5 repealed.
  - SECT. 2. When a divorce is decreed for the cause
- 2 of adultery, hereafter committed, said decree shall not
- 3 have the effect to release the "guilty cause of di-
- 4 vorce" from the bond of matrimony, and said guilty

- 5 party shall be restrained from contracting another 6 marriage until a release is obtained as hereafter pro-7 vided.
- SECT. 3. In all cases where one party shall be di2 vorced from the bond of matrimony, the court may,
  3 on the application of the other party, after three years
  4 from the date of said divorce, grant a like divorce to
  5 said applicant, on such terms and conditions as such
  6 court, in the exercise of a sound discretion, may
  7 judge reasonable.
