STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section eighth of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the revised statutes, relating to fees of constables.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section eight of chapter one hundred 2 and sixteen of the revised statutes, is hereby amended 3 in the second line, by adding after the words cents, the 4 words, "for each juryman summoned," so that the 5 section, as amended, shall read as follows :

6 Sect. 8. The fees of constables for the service, 7 travel and return of each venire, shall be one dollar 8 and fifty cents for each juryman summoned, to be paid 9 out of the county treasury ; and for services which 10 may be performed either by a deputy sheriff or a

11 constable, the constable shall be allowed the same fees
12 as a deputy sheriff, unless otherwise provided by law.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act are hereby repealed.
