STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to chapter one hundred and sixteen of the revised statutes and relating to the fees of registers of deeds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The fee of a register of deeds for recording a deed or mortgage or for a certified copy of the same, shall be sixty cents, instead the fee now prescribed by law.
