STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend the third specification of the eighth section of the seventy-seventh chapter of the revised statutes, relating to the equity powers of the supreme judicial court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The said statute is hereby amended, by
2 adding to the said specification the words, “and to
3 cancel and compel the discharge of such written con-
4 tracts, whether under seal or otherwise, when a full
5 performance or payment shall have been made by the
6 contracting party,” so that, as amended, the same
7 shall read :

8 *Third,* To compel the specific performance of writ-
9 ten contracts, and to cancel and compel the discharge

10 of such written contracts, whether under seal or other-
11 wise, when a full performance or payment shall have
12 been made by the contracting party.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved
2 by the governor.
