STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to increase the bounty on killing bears.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. A bounty of five dollars for every bear
2 killed in any town in this state shall be paid by the
3 treasurer thereof, to the person killing it, on his com-
4 plying with the provisions set forth in chapter thirty,
5 section six, of the revised statutes of eighteen hun-
7 dred and fifty-seven.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with the foregoing section of this act are hereby
3 repealed.
