STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to provide for the registry of lost deeds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Whenever a deed, duly executed and
2 acknowledged, conveying lands located in two or more
3 counties, shall have been lost, after having been re-
4 corded in a part, and only in a part, of such counties,
5 it shall be lawful for the register of deeds in either of
6 the remaining counties to enter upon the records there-
7 of a copy of said deed duly certified by the register of
8 the county, in which the record had been made, to be
9 a true copy from the records thereof. And the copy
10 thus registered shall have the same effect, from and
11 after the date of such new registry, as if it were a
12 record of the original deed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
