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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter six of the revised statutes,  
relating to taxation.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The second specification of the sixth  
2 section of chapter six of the revised statutes, is hereby  
3 amended, by striking out all after the word "second"  
4 to and including the word "institutions" in the fourth  
5 line, and inserting the following words : "all property  
6 which by the articles of separation is exempted from  
7 taxation ; the real and personal property of all literary  
8 institutions," so that said specification, as amended,  
9 shall read as follows :

10 *Second.* All property which by the articles of  
11 separation is exempted from taxation ; the real and

12 personal property of all literary institutions ; and the  
13 real and personal property of all benevolent, charitable  
14 and scientific institutions, incorporated by this state.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
