IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to chapter eighteen of the revised statutes.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION. 1. Section twenty-four of chapter eighteen of the revised statutes is amended to read as follows:

4 *Sect. 24.* In petitions for increase of damages on  
5 account of such ways, the like proceedings may be  
6 had, and the rights of the parties may be determined,  
7 as provided for like purposes respecting highways.  
8 When it appears by the reports of municipal officers,  
9 by the records of towns, or by the records of com-  
10 missioners, that notice was not given as required, such  
11 petitions may be filed with the clerk of the commis-  
12 sioners within two years after a final decision, (and in

13 all other cases such petitions may be filed with said  
14 clerk within one year after a final decision.)

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after  
2 its approval by the governor.
