AN ACT relating to licenses granted by a judge of pro-
bate for sale of real estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

When the time in a license to sell real estate, which
2 has been granted by a judge of probate, on petition,
3 and after public notice, has expired, a new license
4 for the sale of the whole, or a part of the same real
5 estate, for the same purposes, may be granted, with or
6 without notice, at the discretion of the judge, on filing
7 a new bond, as in the case of the original license.
