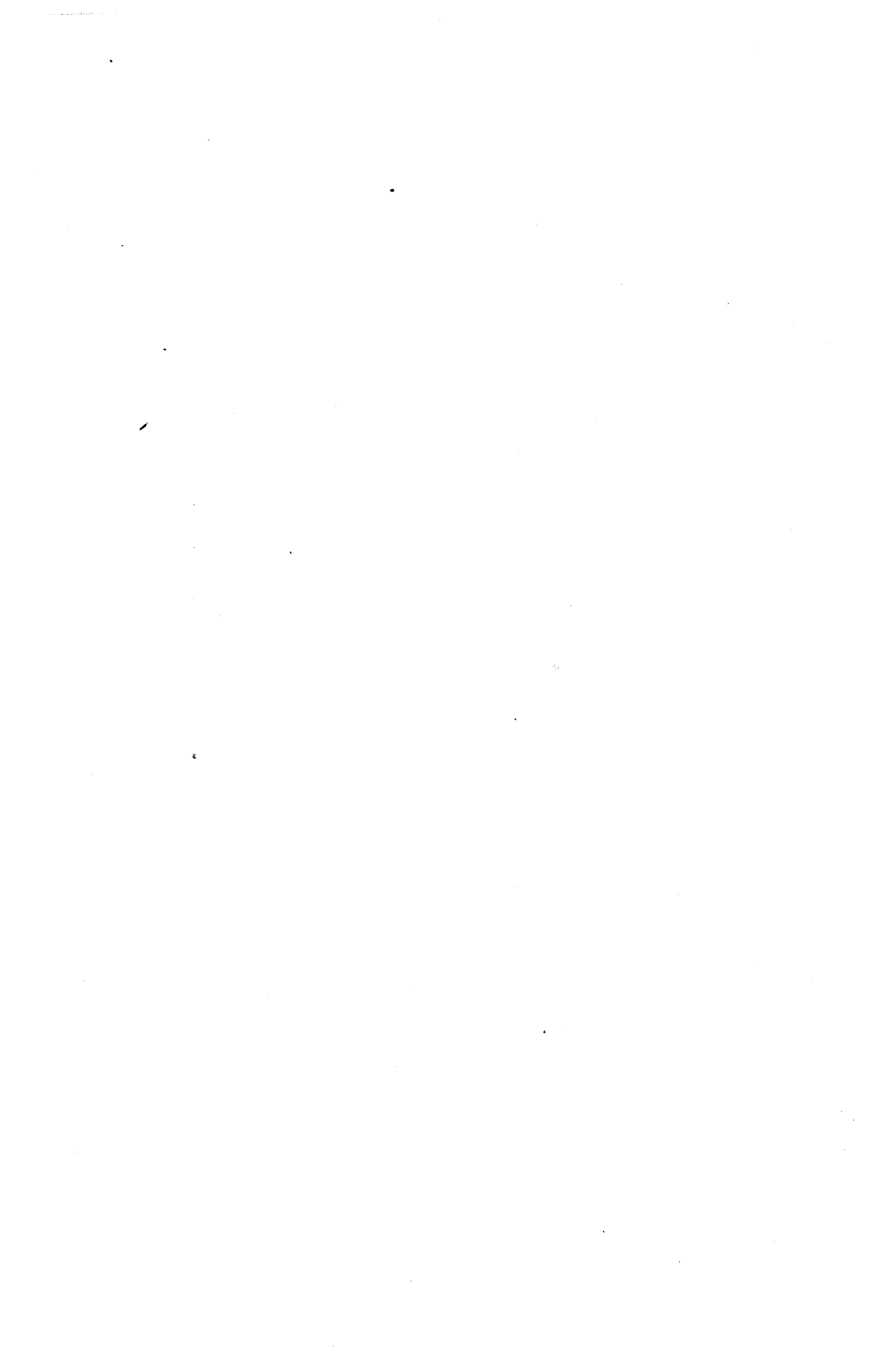

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES in favor of reciprocal commercial intercourse
between the United States and the British North American
Provinces.

Resolved, As an expression of the views of this legis-
2 lature, that the interests of our state and the country
3 at large demand as a basis for commercial intercourse
4 between the United States and the British North
5 American Provinces, a broad and liberal policy, to be
6 secured by a just and impartial reciprocity treaty, or
7 by concurrent legislation.

Resolved, That our senators and representatives in
2 congress be requested to use their influence in favor of
3 such reciprocal treaty or concurrent legislation as may
4 best accomplish this object.
