## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section second, chapter one hundred and thirty of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixtytwo.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section two, chapter one hundred and 2 thirty of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, 3 is hereby amended, by striking out of said section all 4 after the words "person or persons" in the ninth line, 5 so that it shall read as follows:

6 Sect. 2. Immediately after appointing such com-7 missioner, the governor shall issue to the municipal 8 officers of the several cities, towns and plantations of 9 this state, a notice of the name and place of business 10 of said commissioner; and it shall be the duty of such 11 municipal officers to purchase such intoxicating liquors

12 as they may keep on sale for the purpose specified in 13 this act, of such commissioner, or of such other muni-14 cipal officers as have purchased such intoxicating 15 liquors of said commissioner, and of no other person 16 or persons; *provided*, that the commissioner appointed 17 under the provisions of this act, shall be a citizen of 18 Maine, and shall keep his place of business in this 19 state.
