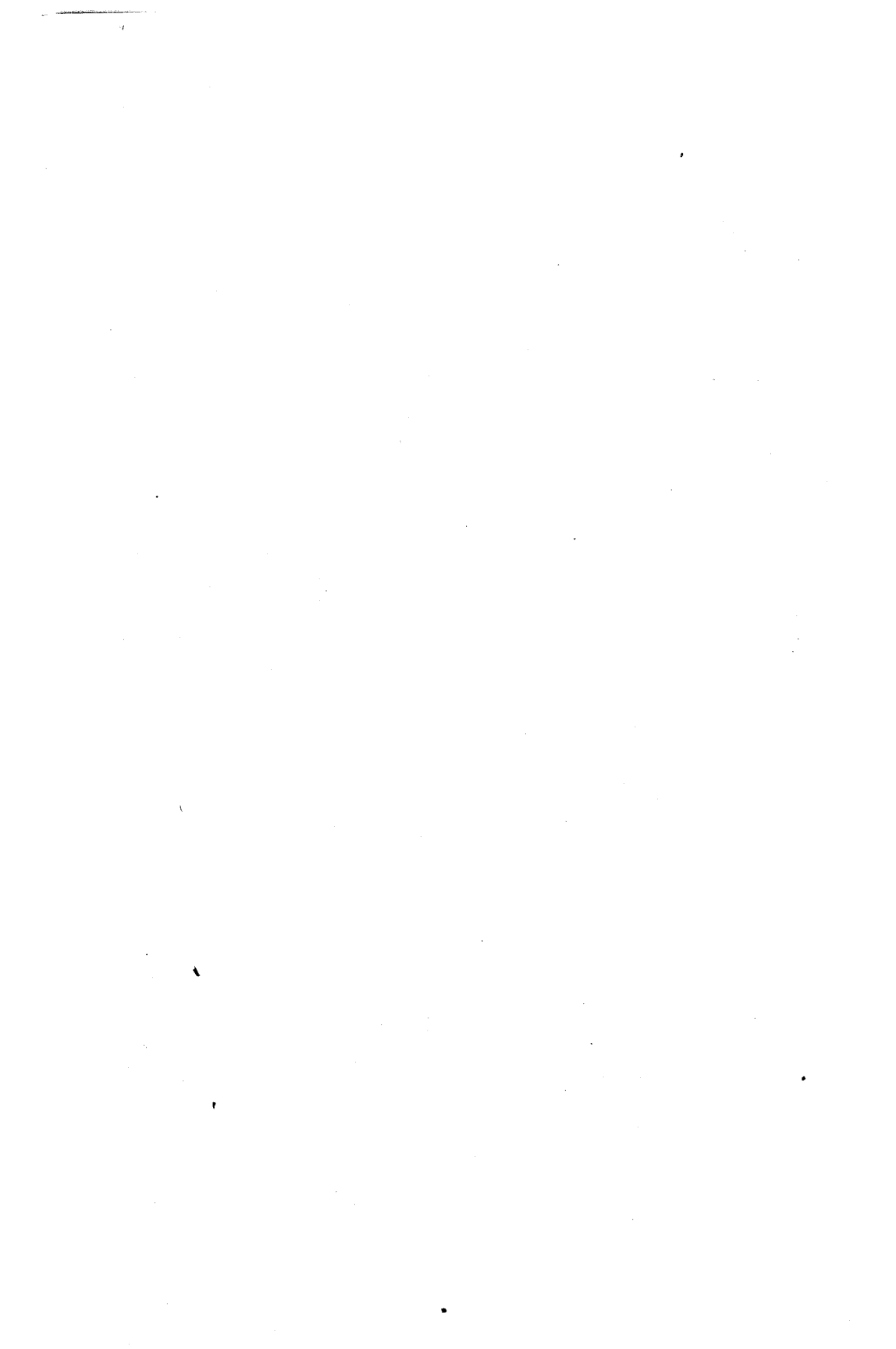
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT entitled an act in addition to and amendatory of section three, chapter one hundred and three of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-two.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Any person or persons violating the provisions of section three, chapter one hundred and three of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, shall be punished by fine not exceeding five hundred dollars, recovered in an action for debt, on the complaint of any school official or person aggrieved.
