STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT relating to evidence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Neither party to the record shall be
2 excused or excluded from testifying in the trial of any
3 action against any executor or administrator, if the
4 party, in whose name the suit is prosecuted, is nominal
5 only, having no interest in the subject matter of the
6 suit, or had assigned, or disposed of his interest during
7 the lifetime of the executor's testator or the adminis-
8 trator's intestate.

SECT. 2. Any act inconsistent herewith is so far
2 repealed, and this act shall be in force from its ap-
3 proval.
