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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

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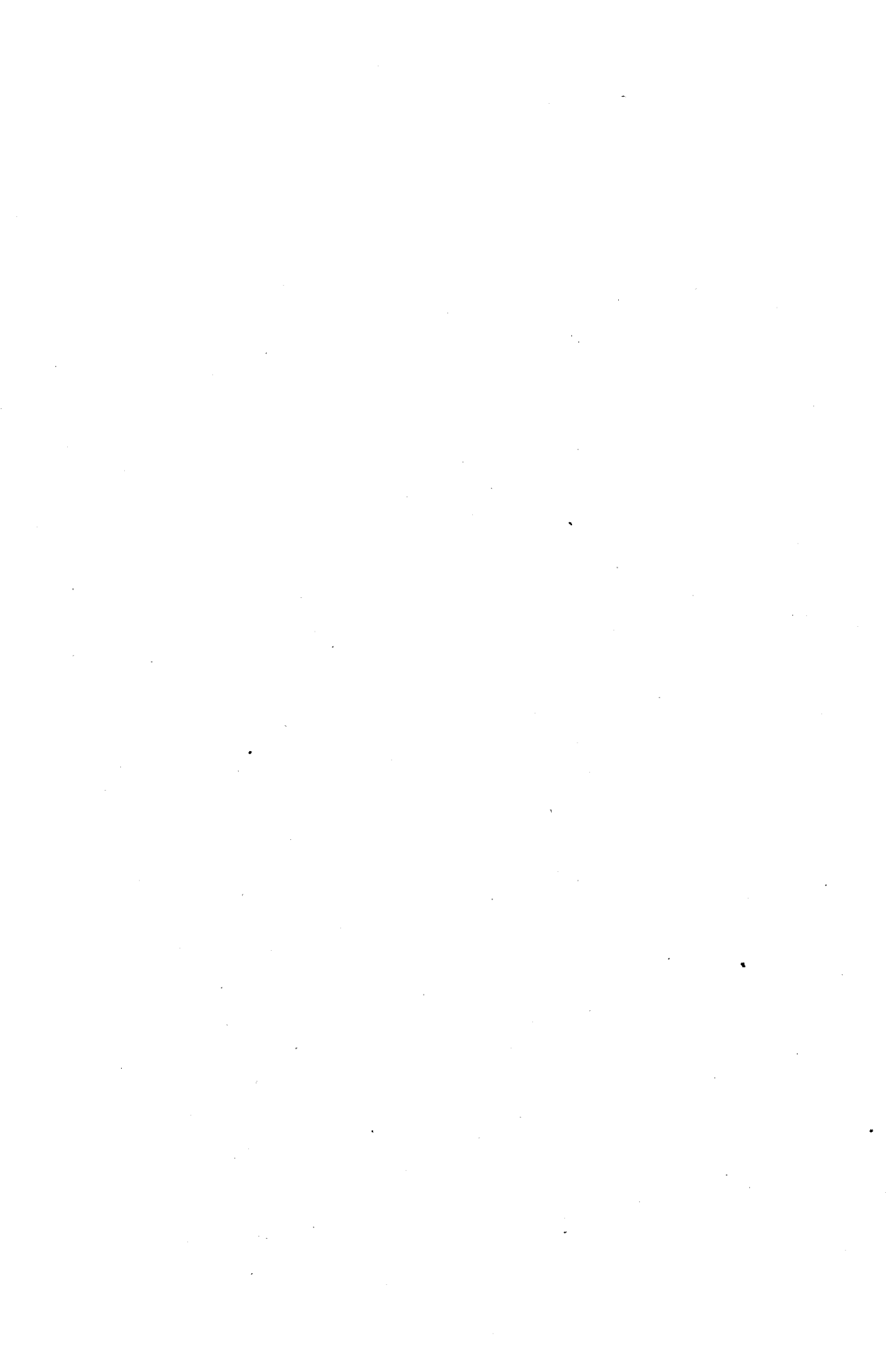
AN ACT in relation to agreements or stipulations relative to the title of personal property bargained and delivered for which a note is given.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. No agreement or stipulation hereafter  
2 made shall be valid, whereby the title to personal  
3 property, bargained and delivered, shall remain the  
4 property of the payee of a note given therefor, unless  
5 the agreement or stipulation is in writing, and made a  
6 part of the note, and signed by the payor or his lawful  
7 agent.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved  
2 by the governor.
