STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to an act to incorporate the Penobscot Log Driving Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. That on all logs exceeding forty feet in 2 length driven by said company under their charter, 3 such additional toll shall be assessed for driving, as 4 in the opinion of the directors shall be reasonable, 5 arising from the increased expense of driving the same.

SECT. 2. Said company may make contracts for 2 driving or assist in driving logs outside of the limits 3 of the company on the Penobscot waters; and for any 4 sum due for such driving, the same lien shall exist 5 and to be enforced in the same manner as is provided 6 for other logs.

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SECT. 3. Said company may build or assist in build-2 ing and keep in repair, any steamboats or other craft, 3 that in their opinion, or in the opinion of the direc-4 tors, may be advantageous in facilitating the progress 5 of the drive, the expense of which may be apportioned 6 upon the logs of different years, as they may think 7 proper.

SECT. 4. This act shall go into effect upon its ap-2 proval.
