STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the towns of Hartland and St. Albans to raise money to aid in the construction of the Pittsfield, Hartland and St. Albans Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The towns of Hartland and St. Albans
2 may each, at any legal meeting duly notified and called
3 for that purpose, raise by tax or loan such sums of
4 money as they shall deem expedient ; not exceeding
5 forty thousand dollars for the town of Hartland, and
6 sixty thousand dollars for the town of St. Albans, and
7 may appropriate the same to aid in the construction of
8 the Pittsfield, Hartland and St. Albans Railroad, in
9 such manner as they shall deem proper ; *provided*, that
10 two-thirds of the legal voters present and voting at
11 such meetings shall vote therefor.

SECT. 2. The towns named in the first section of
2 this act, may each, make such contracts with the
3 Pittsfield, Hartland and St. Albans Railroad Com-
4 pany, for the purpose mentioned in the preceding
5 section, as they may think proper and necessary, and
6 may raise money by tax or loan to carry the same into
7 effect, not exceeding the amount named in the preced-
8 ing section.

SECT. 3. The said towns shall each raise in each
2 year, commencing the third year after a loan shall be
3 effected, should the money be raised by a loan, a sum
4 not less than three per cent. of the amount of such
5 loan, to be applied to the liquidation of the principal
6 of such loan, in addition to the interest, unless the
7 same shall be satisfactorily provided for in some other
8 way.

SECT. 4. The selectmen of the towns named in this
2 act are authorized to vote upon the stock held by said
3 towns at all meetings of said railroad corporation, or
4 appoint an agent for that purpose, by writing, under
5 their hands.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
