STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and thirty-five of the revised statutes, relating to sentence, and its execution in criminal cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section seven of chapter one hundred
- 2 and thirty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amend-
- 3 ed, so as to read as follows:
- 4 Sect. 7. When any person is convicted of a crime
- 5 punishable with death and sentenced therefor, he shall
- 6 at the same time be sentenced to solitary confinement
- 7 and hard labor in the state prison, till such punishment
- 8 is inflicted; but after the expiration of one year from
- 9 the date of sentence, and after the whole record of
- 10 such proceedings or case is certified by the clerk of

- 11 said court, under the seal thereof, to the supreme
- 12 executive authority of the state, the governor may,
- 13 with the advice and consent of the executive council,
- 14 issue his warrant, under the great seal of the state,
- 15 directed to the sheriff of the county wherein the state
- 16 prison is situated, commanding him to carry said sen-
- 17 tence of death into execution.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
