STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter six, section eleven, first division of section of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. That the first division of section eleven, 2 chapter six of the revised statutes, be amended, by 3 inserting the words "or landing," in said first division, 4 after the word "wharf," in the next to the last 5 line ; and by striking out the word "or" before the 6 word "wharf" in the said line, so that said first division of section eleven, chapter six, will read as amended: 7

8 "All goods, wares and merchandise, all logs, timber, 9 boards and other lumber, and all stock in trade, including 10 stock employed in the business of any of the 11 mechanic arts, in any town within this state, other

12 than where the owners reside, shall be taxed in such
13 town, if the owners occupy any store, shop, mill,
14 wharf or landing therein, and shall not be taxable
15 where the owners reside.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
