## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Solon to loan its credit for manufacturing purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Solon may, at any legal 2 meeting duly notified and held for that purpose, raise 3 by tax or loan such sum of money as it shall deem 4 expedient, not exceeding five per cent. of the valua-5 tion of said town as made by the assessors for the year 6 in which said meeting shall be held, and may appro-7 priate the same to aid in the erection of any dams, 8 mills or factories of any kind, in said town of Solon, 9 or at Carritunk falls, in such manner as it shall deem 10 proper; *provided*, that two-thirds of the legal voters 11 present and voting at such meeting shall vote therefor.

SECT. 2. Said town may make such contracts with 2 any person or corporation, now or hereafter existing 3 under the laws of this state, for the purposes mentioned 4 in the preceding section, as it may think necessary, 5 and may raise money by tax or loan to carry the same 6 into effect, not exceeding the amount of said five per 7 cent.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
