IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to enlarge the jurisdiction of the municipal
courts of the cities of Saco and Biddeford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The municipal courts of the cities of Saco and Bid-
2 deford shall have original jurisdiction, concurrent with
3 the supreme judicial court, in all civil actions where
4 the debt or damages do not exceed one hundred dol-
5 lars, in which any party defendant to the action shall
6 reside, or, if not an inhabitant of the state, shall be
7 commorant in the county of York.
