STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and thirty-three of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, relating to collection of penalties against selectmen for not using the check list.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter two hundred 2 and thirty-three of the public laws of the year one 3 thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, is hereby 4 amended so as to read as follows :

5 *Sect. 3.* Any penalty provided for in the two pre- 6 ceding sections hereof, or in said chapter four of the 7 revised statutes, or in the act additional thereto ap- 8 proved February twenty-second, in the year one thou- 9 sand eight hundred and fifty-eight, in case the treasurer

10 refuses or neglects for ten days after written request
11 of any voter to commence a suit therefor, may be
12 recovered by said voter in a suit in his own name, to
13 the same uses as specified in said chapter four.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
