STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT increasing the amount of money which towns shall raise for the support of schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Every city, town and plantation shall
2 raise and expend annually, for the support of schools
3 therein, a sum of money, exclusive of the income of
4 any corporate school fund, or of any grant from the
5 revenue or funds from the state, or of any voluntary
6 donation, devise or bequest, or of any forfeiture accru-
7 ing to the use of schools, not less than one dollar and
8 twenty cents for each inhabitant, according to the cen-
9 sus of the state by which representatives to the legis-
10 lature are or may be hereafter apportioned.

SENATE—No. 44.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
