STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and sixty-five of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, relating to taxable property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and
- 2 sixty-five of the public laws of the year one thousand
- 3 eight hundred and sixty-eight, is hereby amended, so
- 4 as to read as follows:
- 5 Sect. 1. The first division of section eleven of
- 6 chapter six of the revised statutes, is hereby amended,
- 7 so as to read as follows: All goods, wares and mer-
- 8 chandise, all logs, timber, boards and other lumber,
- 9 and all stock in trade, including stock employed in
- 10 the business of any of the mechanic arts in any town

11 within this state other than where the owners reside,
12 shall be taxed in such town, if the owners, their
13 tenants, or any person contracting under them for the
14 building of any house, shop, store or vessel, occupy
15 any store, shop, mill, wharf, landing or shipyard
16 therein, for the purposes of such tenancy or contract,
17 and shall not be taxable where the owner or owners
18 reside, if in this state; but if the owner or owners
19 reside out of this state they shall be taxed as herein20 before provided.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
