STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-four of chapter fiftyone of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section twenty-four of chapter fifty-one of the revised 2 statutes is amended as follows:—By inserting in the 3 second line of said section after the word superintend-4 ent, the words, "or treasurer, or by leaving the same 5 at the office of either," and by striking out in the 6 fourth line of said section the word thirty, and insert-7 ing therein the word "seven," and striking out all of 8 said section after the word dollars, so that said section 9 as amended shall read as follows :

SECTION 24. The owner of land adjoining a railroad, 2 may give written notice to its superintendent, or treas-

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3 urer, or by leaving the same at the office of either, that
4 such fence is not made, or that it needs repair. For
5 neglect to make or repair it for seven days after such
6 notice, the corporation forfeits to such owner one hun7 dred dollars.
