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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

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AN ACT to repeal chapter fifty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, and sections thirty-two, thirty-three, and thirty-four of chapter eighty-four of the revised statutes, and to amend section thirty-one of the same chapter, relating to levy of executions against towns.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Chapter fifty-three of the public laws of 2 eighteen hundred fifty-eight, and sections thirty-two, 3 thirty-three and thirty-four of chapter eighty-four of 4 the revised statutes are hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. Section thirty-one of chapter eighty-four 2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking 3 out in the second and third lines the following words,

4 namely, “and any inhabitant who voluntarily pays his  
5 due proportion or is compelled to satisfy such warrant  
6 in whole or in part,” so that said section as amended  
7 shall read as follows :

8 *Sect. 31.* The owner of any real or personal estate  
9 so sold, may recover against the town, in an action of  
10 assumpsit, the full value thereof with interest at the  
11 rate of twelve per centum yearly, with costs of suit ;  
12 and may prove and recover the real value thereof,  
13 whatever was the price at which it was sold.
