STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend section fourteen of chapter thirty of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

That said section fourteen is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following : “ If any person having in his possession the carcass or hide of any such animal killed within times herein prohibited, shall be convicted under the provisions of this chapter, said carcass or hide shall be decreed by the court imposing such penalty, forfeited to the use of the person prosecuting.”
