## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter nineteen of the laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-eight.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That chapter nineteen of the laws of eighteen hun-

- 2 dred and fifty-eight is hereby amended by striking out
- 3 in first and second lines thereof the words "on lands
- 4 not his own," and inserting the words "in this state,"
- 5 so that said act shall read as follows:
- 6 No person shall hunt or kill with dogs any moose or
- 7 deer in this state under penalty of twenty dollars for
- 8 every such moose or deer so killed; to be recovered by
- 9 complaint or indictment, one half thereof to the state
- 10 and one half to the complainant, and any person may

11 lawfully shoot or kill any dog so found hunting or kill-12 ing moose or deer.
